

**THE CHITTAGONG HILL-TRACTS SARAI
REGULATION, 1951.**

East Bengal Regulation No. I of 1951.

[22nd January, 1951.]

*A Regulation to apply the Sarais Act, 1867, to the
Chittagong Hill-tracts;*

WHEREAS it is expedient to apply the Sarais Act,
1867, to the Chittagong Hill-tracts;

AND WHEREAS by sub-section (2) of section 92 of
the Government of India Act, 1935, as adapted by the
Pakistan (Provisional Constitution) Order, 1947, the
¹[Government] is empowered to make regulations for the
peace and good Government of any area in his Province
which is for the time being an excluded area, or a partially
excluded area;

NOW, THEREFORE, the ²[Government], in exercise
of the said powers and all other powers enabling it in that
behalf, is pleased to make the following Regulation:-

Short title and
commencement

1. (1) This Regulation may be called the
Chittagong Hill-tracts Sarais Regulation, 1951.

(2) It shall come into force on the date of its
publication in the *Official Gazette*.

Application of Act

Chittagong Hill-tracts.
