THE ARMED FORCES (RECRUITMENT AND CONDITIONS OF SERVICE) ACT, 1948

ACT NO. XII OF 1948

[9th June, 1948]

An Act to provide for the regulation and control of the recruitment and conditions of service of the Bangladesh Armed Forces.*

WHEREAS it is necessary to provide for the regulation and control of the recruitment and conditions of service of the Bangladesh Armed Forces;

It is hereby enacted as follows:-

1. (1) This Act may be called the Armed Forces (Recruitment and Conditions of Service) Act, 1948.

Short title, extent and commencement

- (2) It extends to ¹[the whole of Bangladesh].
- (3) It shall come into force at once.
- **2.** The recruitment to the Armed Forces of ²[Bangladesh] including the Army, the Navy and the Air Force shall be governed by rules framed by the Government.

Power to make rules for recruitment

3. The Government shall make Rules for the regulation and control of the conditions of service as respects pay, leave, pensions and general rights of the services mentioned in section 2.

Power to make rules for conditions of service

Throughout this Act, the words "Bangladesh Armed Forces" and "Government" were substituted for the words "Pakistan Armed Forces" and "Central Government" respectively by section 3 and the Second Schedule of the Bangladesh Laws (Revision and Declaration) Act, 1973 (Act No. VIII of 1973).

The words "the whole of Bangladesh" were substituted for the words "all the territories of Pakistan" by section 3 and the Second Schedule of the Bangladesh Laws (Revision and Declaration) Act, 1973 (Act No. VIII of 1973).

The word "Bangladesh" was substituted for the word "Pakistan" by section 3 and the Second Schedule of the Bangladesh Laws (Revision and Declaration) Act, 1973 (Act No. VIII of 1973).
