THE EXCLUDED AND PARTIALLY EXCLUDED AREAS LAWS REGULATION, 1950

East Bengal Regulation No. V of 1950.

[12th September, 1950]

A Regulation to apply the ¹[***] State Aid to Industries Act, 1931, to the Chittagong Hill-tracts and to the partially excluded areas of the Mymensingh district.

WHEREAS it is expedient to apply the Bengal State Aid to Industries Act, 1931, to the Chittagong Hill-tracts and to the partially excluded areas of the Mymensingh district;

AND WHEREAS by sub-section (2) of section 92 of the Government of India Act, 1935, as adapted by the Pakistan (Provisional Constitution) Order, 1947, the ²[Government] is empowered to make regulations for the peace and good Government of any area in his Province which is for the time being an excluded area or a partially excluded area;

Now, THEREFORE, the ²[Government] in exercise of the said powers and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, is pleased to make the following Regulation:-

The word "Bengal" was omitted by Article 6 of the Bangladesh (Adaptation of Existing Laws) Order, 1972 (Presidents Order No. 48 of 1972).

The word "Government" was replaced, for the words "Governor" by Article 9 of the Bangladesh (Adaptation of Existing Laws) Order, 1972 (President's Order No. 48 of 1972).

Short title and commencement

- 1. (1) This Regulation may be called the Excluded and Partially Excluded Areas Laws Regulation, 1950.
- (2) It shall come into force on the date of its publication in the *Official Gazette*.

Application of Bengal Act III of 1931 to the Chittagong Hilltracts and to the partially excluded areas of the Mymenshingh district 2. The ¹[***] State Aid to Industries Act, 1931, shall apply to the Chittagong Hill-tracts and to the partially excluded areas of the Mymensingh district.
